Implementation of activities

Welfare to the Pro-poor

We were able to reach 100s of pro poor with livelihood program.

Medical Missions

Activities focused on the supply of medicines and consumables and construction works on the surgical and medical wards of CFCH.

Evangelism and Missions outreach

Evangelism activities were carried out in some rural communities where CFCM had planted churches. Construction of church buildings was started. CFCM bought lands, rocks, sand, cement, steel rods, and lumbers for the four church buildings.

The Church at Sea

Major maintenance works were carried out on the canoe, net, and outboard motor. Hence, there were not many sea-going activities as the fishermen faced the challenge of foreign trawlers, inadequate fuel for the sea voyages, and sea current that was destroying their nets.

Coast for Christ Academy of the Coast for Christ ministries continued to give formal education to the young and also gave scholarships to poor but intelligent children in Sankor and Winneba communities.
